



Care and Maintenance of Your American Teardrop Camping Trailer

- 1) Security and Safety:
 - a) Lock the rear hatch and the side doors when traveling or when the trailer is moving with the keys.
 - b) Make sure the jack stands are in the full upright position before moving the trailer.
 - c) Close the roof vent to the closed position before moving the trailer.
 - d) Make sure the hitch and chain has been connected, properly secured, and tongue wheel removed before moving/towing the trailer.
 - e) It is against the law for any person to ride inside the trailer when moving or being towed.
- 2) Storage: It is highly recommended to store your trailer in a covered area or under a waterproof protective cover. Waterproof Covers are available for purchase. Failure to keep trailer covered during storage will void the warranty.
- 3) Maintenance: Due to the movement of the trailer, small leaks are possible around doors and hatch. They can be re-sealed using a neutral cure silicone. Do not use household construction silicone to seal leaks as this contains acid that will eat into the aluminum.
- 4) Cleaning: A mild detergent solution is recommended to wash the exterior surface. The carpet and floor inside can be vacuumed. Household cleaner can be used for all interior surfaces.
